This opportunity is designed for students interested in reinforcing expository writing skills acquired during a year of distance learning, reducing the impact of summer loss, and entering the next grade "writing-ready."

Instructors:

Dr. Chris Schoberl has been a middle school educator and English teacher for more than 35 years, receiving his initial training from Dr. Lucy Calkins at Columbia University's Writing Project, where Ashbrook's writing curriculum was developed. Chris was recently named Head of School of Ashbrook Independent School.

Miss Amanda Kelley is a 5th grade teacher at Ashbrook Independent School. Throughout the year, including distance learning, she integrated Lucy Calkins and Traits Writing into her daily English curriculum. She graduated from Western Oregon University with her Bachelors of Science in Education.

These one-week workshops meet 5 days a week, 8:30am to 12:30pm. Spots are available on a first come, first served basis and open to Ashbrook and non-Ashbrook students.

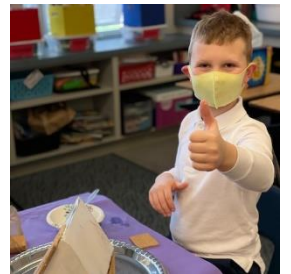
